1. This writ petition is filed against the order passed by the Divisional Commissioner, Amravati Division, Amravati in Revision Application No.128/RTS-64/Sakri/2018-2019 dated 04.03.2024.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent No.1/State raised a preliminary objection about the maintainability of the present petition before this Court. He also relied upon the judgment passed by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the matter of *Gurudassing Nawoosing Panjwani Vs. The State of Maharashtra and Others* reported in 2015(6) MhLJ. 915 decided on 06.11.2015, and contended that against the order passed by the Divisional Commissioner, the petitioner is having an alternate and efficacious remedy to file a revision before the State Government. In view of that, the writ petition is **disposed of**, as not maintainable. No order as to costs.

3. This writ petition is **disposed of**, with liberty to file an appeal before the State Government. Delay, if any, be considered by the Appellate Authority while considering the application for delay.
