1. Heard Mr.R.L.Khapre, learned Senior counsel for the petitioner and Mr. A.G.Mate, learned AGP for respondent nos.2 to 4 and Mr. A.M.Ghare, learned counsel for respondent nos.7.
2. The petitioner has challenged the order passed under Section 18 (4) of Maharashtra Money-Lending(Regulation) Act, 2014 by the Divisional Joint Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Amravati in Appeal No.8/2021.
3. The learned counsel for the respondents, pointed out that the petitioner has an alternate and equally efficacious remedy of filing a revision under Section 9 of the Maharashtra Money-Lending (Regulation)Act, 2014 before the Registrar General of Money Lending, Maharashtra State, Pune.
4. In view thereof, the petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file revision before Registrar General of Money Lending, Maharashtra State, Pune within a period of six weeks from today.
5. The delay caused while prosecuting the present petition shall be considered by the Revisional Authority while deciding the petitioner's application for condonation of delay, from the date of

filing of the petition.

6. The interim protection granted earlier shall continue to operate for a period of six weeks from today. Upon expiry of the said period, the interim protection shall stand vacated automatically without further reference to the Court.
