2. The petitioner is challenging the order dated 27.10.2023 passed by the Additional Commissioner, Amravati Division, Amravati in Revision No.73/RTS-59-Khudawatpur/Buldhana/2023
3. The petitioner is having an alternate and equally efficacious remedy against the order passed by the Additional Commissioner, Amravati, to file a second revision before the State Government and this issue is already considered by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the matter *Gurudassing Nawoosing Panjwani Vs. State of*

Maharashtra and Others reported in *2015 AIR SCW 6277 SUPREME COURT* decided on *06.11.2015*. In view thereof, the writ petition is disposed of, as not maintainable. No order as to costs.
