1. The present writ petition is filed against the order passed by the Additional Commissioner, Amravati Division, Amravati in Revision Application No.61/RTS-59/Khanjamabad 2014-15 dated 30.04.2024.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent No.1/State raised a preliminary objection about the maintainability of the present petition before this Court. He also relied upon the judgment passed by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the matter of *Gurudassing Nawoosing Panjwani Vs. The State of Maharashtra and Others* reported in 2015(6) MhLJ. 915 decided on 06.11.2015, and contended that against the order passed by the Additional Commissioner, the petitioner is having an alternate and efficacious remedy to file a revision before the State Government. In view of that, the writ petition is **disposed of**, as not maintainable. No order as to costs.

3. The petitioner may file revision before the State Government within a period of four weeks. The authority may consider the period lapsed while prosecuting the present writ petition, while considering the application for delay.
