1. Heard Mr. Yash Maheshwari, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr. H.N. Jaipurkar, learned AGP for the respondent/State.
2. The petitioner is challenging the Order dated 29.01.2024 passed by the Additional Commissioner, Nagpur, whereby the action under section 48(7) of the Maharashtra Land Revenue Code, 1966 (for short "MLRC") was taken against the petitioner. As the order was passed under section 48(7) of the MLRC, the petitioner is having an alternate and equally efficacious remedy to file Appeal under section 247 of the MLRC.
3. In view thereof, the petition is **disposed of** as not maintainable. The petitioner is at liberty to file an appeal, within a period of four weeks from today. Time spent in prosecuting the present petition shall be taken into consideration by the appellate authority while, considering the application for condonation of delay. No order as to costs.
