1. Heard Mr. R.P. Kothari, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. A.A. Madiwale, learned AGP for respondent/State.
2. The petitioner is challenging the order dated 29.11.2023 passed by the Additional Commissioner, Nagpur in Appeal No.7/LND-31/2016-17.
3. The petitioner is having an alternate and equally efficacious remedy against the order passed by the Additional Commissioner, Nagpur, to file a revision before the State Government and this issue is already considered by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the matter *Gurudassing Nawoosing Panjwani Vs. State of Maharashtra and Others* reported in *2015 AIR SCW 6277 SUPREME COURT* decided on *06.11.2015*. In view thereof, the writ petition is **disposed of**, as not maintainable. No order as to costs.

4. The petitioner may file revision before the State Government within a period of four weeks. Delay in prosecuting the present writ petition be taken into consideration while, considering the application for condonation of delay.
