CIVIL APPLICATION (F) NO. 261 OF 2025

1) The applicant/appellant moved this application to condone the delay of 305 days caused in filing the appeal, for which learned counsel appearing for respondents has given no objection.

CIVIL APPLICATION (F) NO. 1745 OF 2025
