5. Since respondent No.4 has not complied the order dated 23/09/2025 without any valid reason and has not made any attempt to comply order, willful disobedience is apparent. We will accordingly hear the petitioner on punishment on the next date, of course by giving one more opportunity to him to comply the order dated 23/09/2025.
