2. Ms. S.S. Jachak, learned A.P.P. on instructions from the Assistant Commissioner of Police Ms. Anita More, Lakadganj Police Station, submits that after having gone through the CCTV Footage appropriate instructions are issued to record the statement of the complainant.
