1) The applicant/appellant has filed this application to permit him to withdraw the amount deposited by the respondent No.3 in the Court, for which learned counsel for the respondent No.3 has given no objection, as the appeal has already been disposed of on 07/02/2024.

6) His statement is accepted as an undertaking to the Court. If the respondent No.3 fails to deposit the said amount within the stipulated time, necessary orders will be passed against it.
