1) The appellant Insurance Company moved this application for permitting it to withdraw the statutory amount of Rs.25,000/- and entire compensation amount of Rs.9,35,897/- deposited by it and lying in this Court, for which learned counsel for respondents No.1 to 4 'claimants' and learned counsel for respondent No.6 'driver' have given no objection.

2) None appears for respondent No.5.

3) It also appears that by judgment dated 25/04/2025, the appeal filed by the Insurance Company was allowed and the Insurance Company was exonerated from the liability to pay compensation and original respondents Nos. 1 and 2, i.e. respondent Nos. 5 and 6 herein, have been held jointly and severally to pay the said compensation.

4) In view of the same, the application is allowed as prayed. The applicant/appellant Insurance Company is permitted

to withdraw the said amount along with interest accrued thereon, if any, lying in the court.

5) The Registrar (J) is directed to transfer the said amount to the bank account of the applicant/appellant Insurance Company within four weeks on furnishing its bank account details to the Registry.
