application that the aforesaid respondent could not be served for want of correct address. Thus, the appellants want to serve aforesaid respondent by way of paper publication.

Hence, considering the reasons mentioned in the application, substituted service be effected upon **R.No. 7** by publishing a notice in widely circulated local daily newspaper 'Lokshahi Varta Marathi' in terms of **Order V Rule 20 (1-A) of C.P.C.**, returnable within five weeks from the date of publication of notice.

There is further prayer **regarding deletion of the name of R.Nos. 8 and 9** from the array of respondents. It is stated in the application that the aforesaid respondents were reported to be dead. Thus, the appellants want to delete the name of R.Nos. 8 and 9. The counsel for the appellants is permitted to delete the name of aforesaid respondents at their own risk. Necessary amendment be carried out in the matter.

Counsel to take steps for **deceased R.No. 6** within a period of two weeks.
