1. Apprehending the arrest at the hands of Police in connection with Crime No.412/2025 registered with Police Station Tiosa, District Amravati for the offence punishable under Section 305(a) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, the Applicant approached to this Court for grant of pre arrest bail.

2. Heard learned Counsel for the Applicant, who submitted that as per the allegation, the Applicant has committed a theft of gold locket from the house of Informant. On the basis of the said report, Police have registered the crime.

3. He submitted that, merely on suspicion the present Applicant is arraigned as an accused. As far as his custodial interrogation is concerned, which is not required.

The entire prosecution case is rested on the statement of the daughter of the Informant but she has not seen the present Applicant committing the theft. In view of that, the Applicant be protected by granting anticipatory bail.

4. Learned APP strongly opposed the said application on the ground that golden chain is to be recovered from the present Applicant, and therefore, his custodial interrogation is required.

5. On hearing both the sides and on perusal of the investigation papers, it reveals that, merely on suspicion the present Applicant is arraigned as an accused. As far as his custodial interrogation is concerned, which can be taken care of by imposing certain conditions. In view of that, the Application deserves to be allowed. Accordingly, I proceed to pass the following order:

ORDER

- i. The Application is **allowed**.
- ii. In the event of the arrest, the Applicant-Vedant Gajanan Bahe in connection with Crime No.412/2025 registered with Police Station Tiosa, District Amravati for the offence punishable under Section 305(a) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, be released on anticipatory bail, on executing P.R. Bond in the sum of Rs.25,000/- with one solvent surety in the like amount.

- iii. The Applicant shall attend the concerned Police Station once in a week i.e. on every Sunday between 10.00 a.m. to 01.00 p.m. and shall cooperate with the investigating agency.
 - iv. The Applicant shall not induce, threat or promise any witnesses who are acquainted with the facts of the case either personally or by way of electronic media.
6. Pending application/s, if any, shall stand disposed of accordingly.
