Petition seeking bail in respect of Crime No.334 of 2024 registered for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 333, 296(b), 324(4), 118(1), 109 and 351(3) of BNS, is on board for consideration.

2. The incarceration of the petitioner being from 11.12.2024 pleading innocence on the part of the petitioner and false implication in the case, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks indulgence of this Court. He also submits that due to previous enmity, a false complaint has been given by the de facto complainant and the petitioner was arrested since he happens to be the friend of the main accused. He also submits that the petitioner is ready to abide by any stringent condition that may be imposed by this court.

3. The case of the prosecution as putforth by the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent police, opposing for grant of bail, is that since the first accused, who is the neighbour of the de facto complainant, created a ruckus with all his neighbours in an inebriated condition, the de facto complainant had questioned the same, due to which, the first accused along with the petitioner and another accused trespassed into the house of the de facto complainant abused him in filthy language and assaulted the daughter of the de facto complainant with knife causing injuries and damaged the household articles. He also submits that the injured was discharged from the hospital and the petitioner is arrayed as A2, against whom, five previous cases are pending.

4. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) for the respondent Police and perused the materials available on record, and also considering the period of incarceration undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions and accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only)** with **two sureties**, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned **V Metropolitan Magistrate, Egmore**, and on further conditions that :

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent Police, everyday at 06.30 p.m., until further orders;

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the

conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]***;

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of B.N.S.
