Prayer: This petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent to pay interest to the petitioner at the rate of 18% per annum for the period of delay from 01.03.2023 to 29.10.2024 in paying the amounts paid towards his terminal benefits namely EPF Employee's Contribution, Gratuity and Encashment of leaves within a time frame fixed by this Court and pass orders.

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ORDER

By consent of both parties, this writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission itself.

2. This writ petition is filed seeking to issue a Writ of Mandamus, Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent to pay interest to the directing the respondent to pay interest to the petitioner at the rate of 18% per annum for the period of delay from 01.03.2023 to 29.10.2024 in paying the amounts paid towards his terminal benefits namely EPF Employee's Contribution, Gratuity and Encashment of leaves, within a time frame fixed by this Court and pass orders.

3.The case of the petitioner is that the petitioner joined the Respondent Transport Corporation as Conductor on 08.03.1987 and retired as Junior Clerk on 02.08.1993. Inspite of the petitioner retired on 02.08.1993 his terminal benefits were settled only on 30.10.2024. Hence, the petitioner is entitled to interest for the belated payment made by the



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respondent due to which, the petitioner gave a representation to the respondents on 04.12.2024. However, no action has been taken by the respondents till date. Hence this petition.

4.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that it would be suffice if this Court issues a direction to the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation and pass orders.

5.The learned standing counsel appearing for the respondents submitted that the representation of the petitioner will be considered and will pay the eligible amount with 6% interest P.A as per the earlier orders of this Court.

6.Considering the facts of the case and the submissions made by either side counsel, this Court directs the Respondent/Corporation to pay the eligible amount as payable to the petitioner along with interest at the rate of 6% per annum for the delay period in settling the said amount. This payment shall be made within a period of eight weeks from the date



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of receipt of a copy of this order. It is made clear that if the amount is not paid within the time frame fixed by this Court, it will fetch an interest at the rate of 12% per annum from the date on which the amount became due and payable till the date of actual disbursement.

7. With the above directions, this Writ Petition stands disposed of.
