The petitioner is directed to appear before the 2nd respondent and extend their co-operation. The petitioner is given protection till the conclusion of the enquiry. If the 2nd respondent registers any FIR against the petitioner, he will be given due notice, so that he will get breathing time to move this Court for the relief of Anticipatory Bail.

4. I have not gone into the merits of the case and accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of with the above direction.
