ORDER

Heard the party in person, who submitted the history of the case in detail.

“Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the 4th respondent to consider and pass orders on the petitioner's representations dated 25.07.2024 and 10.08.2024 with regard to the inspection of Books of accounts and records of the 5th



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respondent and send report based on the communicate letter bearing No. 8/62/2020/CL-II (SR) dated 25.11.2020.”

3. The said writ petition was withdrawn by the petitioner and no liberty was granted to file a fresh writ petition.

4. In view thereof, the second writ petition for the same prayer cannot be entertained by this Court, and as such, the writ petition stands dismissed.
