2. When the matter was taken up for hearing, learned Deputy Solicitor General appearing for the first respondent submitted that during the pendency of this writ petition, the second appeal dated 12.02.2024 filed by the petitioner under Section 19(3) of Right of Information Act, 2005 has been disposed of on 19.03.2025. If the petitioner is aggrieved by the said order dated 19.03.2025, he is at liberty to challenge the same in the manner known
