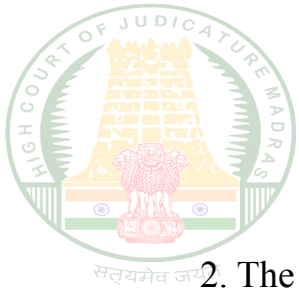
2. In view thereof, this Criminal Appeal is dismissed as having abated.
