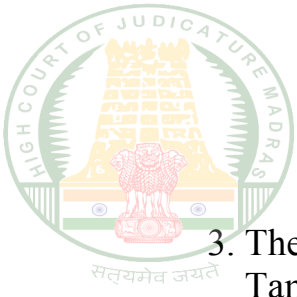

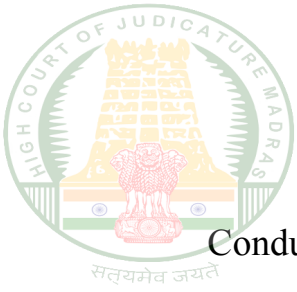

ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed in the nature of a Mandamus, seeking a direction against the respondents to pay interest at 10% per annum for the delayed payment of terminal benefits, such as provident fund, gratuity, leave salary and commutation of pension amount to the petitioners.

2. The writ petitioners had joined the service of the first respondent as



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Conductors, Drivers, and Technical Staff. After putting in nearly 25 to 30 years of continuous service, they had either taken voluntary retirement or retired on attaining the age of superannuation, on various dates. It is contended that the provident fund, gratuity, leave salary and commutation of pension amount had not been settled. It has been stated that they were settled much later, after retirement. Now, by this Writ Petition, they claim interest at the rate of 10% per annum.

3. The respondents may examine each one of the cases individually and examine the reason for the belated payment of provident fund, gratuity, leave salary, and commutation of pension amount. The respondents are under an obligation to pay interest at the rate of 6% per annum. The amount may be disbursed within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4. With the above observations, this Writ Petition is disposed of. No
