4. Recording the same, the writ petition stands disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

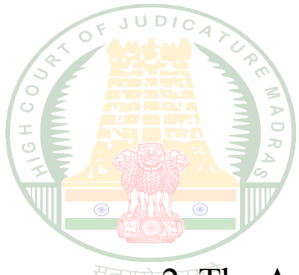
