This case is taken up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both
the parties are present. The learned counsel for the appellant
Mr.P.Dinesh kumar for Mr.T.Chandrasekaran, counsel for the petitioner
on record and the learned counsel for the respondents Mr.K.Premkumar
are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and
conciliation between both parties, they arrived at a compromise to settle
the matter as follows:

TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

The Tribunal has awarded a sum of Rs.43,10,000/- with interest at
7.5% per annum and costs, from the date of petition, till the date of



realisation. Challenging the quantum of compensation, the appellant / Transport Corporation had preferred the present appeal.

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2. After due deliberation and consultation, both the parties have agreed to settle the claim for a sum of Rs.50,00,000/- (Rupees Fifty Lakhs only) in full quit.

3. The appellant/ Transport Corporation is directed to deposit the modified award amount Rs.50,00,000/- in full quit, less the amount of Rs.25,000/- which was already deposited to the credit of MCOP.No.1407 of 2021 before the Motor Vehicles Accident Claims Tribunal, (Chief Judge, Court of Small Causes) at Chennai, **in two installments.** It is made clear that the first installment shall be made within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and the balance award amount shall be paid within a period of one month thereafter. The shares of the minors can be deposited as per the apportionment fixed by the Tribunal.

4. The share of the minor claimants 1 and 2 shall be deposited in any one of the nationalised banks till they attain majority. Mr.Shyam Chander is permitted to withdraw the already accrued interest of the minors' shares and also once in three months from the Bank directly for the benefit of the minors.

5. The award is modified accordingly and the Civil Miscellaneous Appeal is disposed of. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition



is closed.
