Prayer : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the 2nd respondent to survey and demarcate the boundaries in the petitioners land to an extent of 0.0402.0 sq.mts situated in Survey No 98/20 in Kamanayakanur, Vasanthapurma Village, Namakkal District in light of the petiitoner's representation dated 23.08.2024.

ORDER

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2.Heard Mr.K.S.Karthik Raja, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and Mr.A.Selvendran, learned Special Government Pleader appearing on behalf of respondents 1 to 3.

3.The petitioner is claiming right and title over the subject property through a Sale Certificate dated 10.02.2022. The patta was also transferred in the name of the petitioner through proceedings of the Tahsildar dated 08.07.2022 and the Thoraya Patta was issued in Patta No.42. The petitioner wanted a survey to be conducted in the subject property and for demarcation of boundaries. Hence, a representation was made. Since the same was not considered, the present writ petition has been filed before this Court.

4.Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the materials placed before this Court, there shall be a direction to the petitioner to submit a



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proper online application before the 2nd respondent by paying the necessary charges seeking for survey of the subject property. On receipt of the same, the 2nd and 3rd respondents shall act upon the same and conduct the survey for demarcation of boundaries based on the title document and the patta that has already been issued. That process shall be completed, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the on-line application from the petitioner.

5.This writ petition is disposed of with the above directions. No Costs.
