Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed. There shall be no order as to costs.

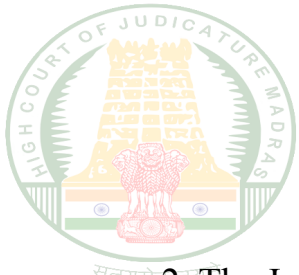
