Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of certiorarified mandamus by calling for Regulation 5, Category 2 of the Madras Metropolitan Development Authority Service Regulations, 1980, insofar as it provides that one must have experience for a period of not less than four years as Assistant Planner in Madras Metropolitan Development Authority or Assistant Director of the Town and Country Planning Department of the State Government or in both to be considered on direct recruitment and quash the same



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and consequently, direct the first respondent to make direct recruitment to the post of Deputy Planner as per the ratio provided under the Service Regulations by ensuring that professionally qualified and experienced Town Planners working in other than CMDA/Government are also considered for direct recruitment.
