ORDER

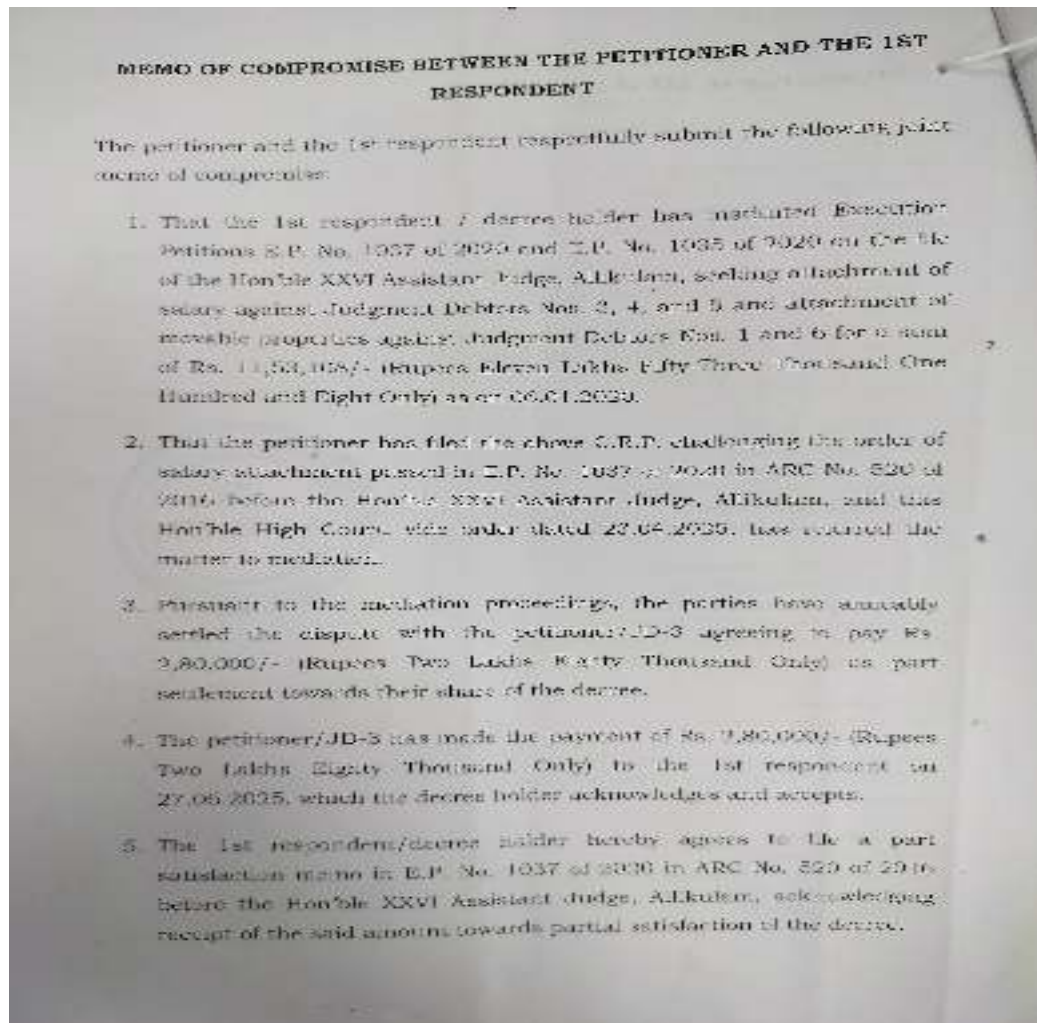

2. When the matter was listed on 23.04.2025, this Court, finding that there is a possibility of settlement had referred the matter to the Mediation Centre.

3. Pursuant to the mediation, the matter was settled between the parties, namely, the petitioner and the 1st respondent and a joint compromise memo dated 11.07.2025, has been entered into between the parties. The joint compromise memo dated 11.07.2025, is extracted hereunder:

6. The 1st respondent further agrees not to pursue any additional claims or attachments against Judgment Debtor No. 3. The 1st respondent also agrees that the amount deducted from the salary of Judgment Debtor No. 3 and deposited in the execution proceedings shall be paid to Judgment Debtor No. 3 to the extent of such deductions. Further, the 1st respondent shall raise no objection to any petition filed by Judgment Debtor No. 3 for the raising the salary attachment accordingly.

7. The 1st respondent/decree holder shall, however, reserve the right to proceed against all other Judgment Debtors who are payable by all legal means, including attachment of movable properties, as per E.P. No. 1035 of 2020 pending before the Hon'ble XXVI Assistant Judge, Muddalur, for recovery of the balance dues of amount.

8. The Respondents-2, who are not necessary parties in this Settlement agreement. Therefore, it is prayed before Hon'ble Court shall record this joint memo of compromise and thus render justice.
