3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioners are innocent; that they have been falsely implicated in this case and they are college students and are ready to abide by any condition put forth by this Court and hence, prayed for grant of anticipatory bail.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police re-iterated the prosecution case and on instructions submitted that FIR has been registered and hence, this petition is liable to be dismissed.

5. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) for the respondent and also perused the materials available on record.

6. Considering the submissions made on either side, it is clear that FIR has been registered and hence, the petition is dismissed with a liberty to the petitioners to file a fresh anticipatory bail mentioning the crime number.
