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filed by the petitioner on the same day, on merits in connection with the case in Crime No.906 of 2024 pending investigation on the file of the 2nd Respondent Police.

ORDER

This petition is filed for a direction directing the learned Special Judge for SC & ST Act cases/Principal District Judge, Thiruvallur, to accept the surrender of the petitioner herein concerned in Crime No.906/2024 on the file of the Inspector of Police, Thiruttani Police Station, Thiruttani District and consider the bail petition on the same day since the offences are pertaining to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

2. In view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and also taking into consideration of the possibility of misusing the pious intention of the Parliament against innocent persons, there shall be a direction to the learned Special Judge for SC & ST Act cases/Principal District Judge, Thiruvallur, to consider the petitioner's bail application, preferably on the same day of their



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surrender in connection with Crime No.906/2024 and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity to the victim under Section 15(a) of the SC/ST Act. The petitioner shall surrender before the concerned jurisdictional Court within a period of fifteen days from the date of the receipt of a copy of this Order.

3. It is needless to say that the Court below while disposing the bail petition shall look into the gravity of the offence, previous antecedents of the petitioner and pass orders. Mere direction issued by this Court to consider the bail petition on the same day does not amount to consider it favourably.

4. With the above direction, the Criminal Original Petition stands allowed.
