The impugned orders have been issued without notice to the petitioner without traversing through the facts of the case and the documents the impugned orders are quashed and the matter is remitted back to the 2nd respondent for fresh consideration after due notice to the petitioner and giving him an opportunity of personal hearing. The impugned orders shall be treated as a show cause notice and an explanation shall be submitted by the petitioner. Thereafter, within a period of 2 months, the 2nd respondent shall pass orders on merits and in accordance with law.

3. With the above direction, this writ petition is allowed. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petitions are closed. No costs.
