3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the respondent has not chosen to enter appearance despite service of notice. I find that the service of notice has been completed on the respondent and the name of the respondent is also printed in the cause list for list of today's cases. The respondent is called and set ex-parte.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is living with her mother at Chennai after the demise of her father and due to her health issues, the Doctor advised her not to travel long time and hence, she is unable to appear before the above said case. Due to the petitioner's health condition and age old mother, it is very difficult for the petitioner to attend for each and every hearings at Chengalpattu. It is the specific contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that no prejudice would be caused to the respondent, if the transfer request made by the petitioner/wife is acceded to.



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5.I have gone through the affidavit filed in support of the transfer petition as well. I find merit in the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

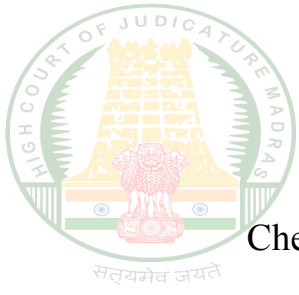
