PRAYER in W.P.No.5769 of 2011: The writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of Certiorarified Mandamus to call for the records in letter/communication dated 28.02.2011 on the file of the 2nd respondent clubbing and rejecting issues pertaining to grievances, House Rent Allowance and transfer of the petitioner and quash the entire proceedings and consequentially forbear the respondents from revising and applying 20% of the HRA for Madurai City to the petitioner.

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ORDER
