ORDER

This writ petition has been filed for issue of writ of mandamus directing the 2nd respondent to conduct enquiry based on the representation made by the petitioner seeking for cancellation of patta that has been issued in favour of respondents 4 to 8 with respect to the subject property.

2.Heard Mr.R.Gopinath, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and Mr.A.Selvendran, learned Special Government Pleader appearing on behalf of respondents 1 to 3.

3.The grievance of the petitioner is that the respondents 4 to 8 had managed to obtain the patta with respect to the property which is actually a passage that is used by all the villagers and which is being used as a pathway by the petitioner to approach his agricultural lands. Hence,the petitioner made a representation to the 1st respondent seeking for the cancellation of patta. On receipt of the same, the 1st respondent through a communication dated 06.08.2020 directed the 2nd respondent to conduct an enquiry. Even thereafter, there was no progress and hence, the present writ petition has been filed before



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4. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the materials placed before this Court, there shall be a direction to the 2nd respondent to deal with the representation made by the petitioner on 28.07.2020 which was forwarded by the 1st respondent through communication dated 06.08.2020, after affording opportunity to respondents 4 to 8 and pass final orders on its own merits and in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

5. This writ petition is disposed of with the above directions. No Costs.
