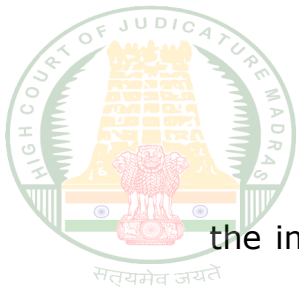

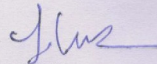

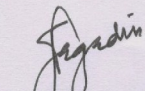
MEMO FILED BY THE WRIT PETITIONER

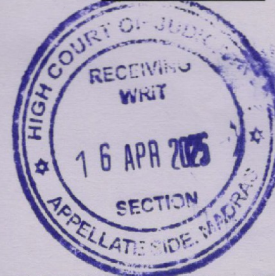
