2. Recording the same, the present writ petition is dismissed as infructuous. No costs.

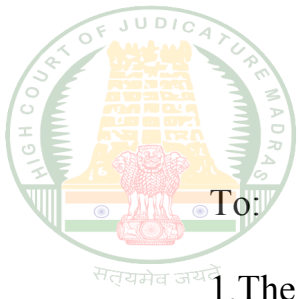
