ORDER

2.H.M.O.P.No.1426 of 2021 was filed by the respondent/husband seeking divorce on the ground of cruelty. After the evidence was completed, the petitioner herein has come forward with the applications to reopen and recall the evidence of P.W.1.

3. The only reason that has been stated in the affidavit filed in support of the application is that vital questions have been omitted. The application appears to have been filed in a very cursory manner and appears to be made with the intent of protracting the proceedings, particularly when the evidence has been completed and the matter is posted for arguments.
