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2.The learned Government Advocate (CrI.Side) for the 5th respondent submitted that the complaint given by the petitioner was taken on file in C.S.R.No.175 of 2025 and after conducting a detailed enquiry, it was closed.

3.From the materials on record, it is seen that the entire allegations made in the complaint are civil in nature between the petitioner and the respondents 6 & 7. Therefore, no police protection is given. The petitioner is at liberty to approach the Civil Court with appropriate jurisdiction.
