PRAYER Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the Respondents 2 and 3 to personally depute their officials, inspect the same and remove the obstacles created by the Respondents 4 and 5 to the petitioner's house and make way



for the petitioner to reach his residential house constructed by him in Grama Natham lands measuring 00.2.00 Ares, comprised in Survey No.10/32 in Keezhvilasai village, Akkarapatti Revenue Village / Thandarampattu Taluk, Tiruvannamalai District.

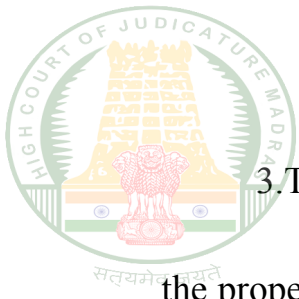

ORDER

This writ petition has been filed for issue of writ of mandamus directing the 2nd and 3rd respondents to act upon the representation made by the petitioner wherein, the petitioner has sought for the removal of obstacles created by respondents 4 and 5 by blocking the way which is the only access for the petitioner to reach his residential house in S.No.10/32 at Keezhvilasai Village, Akkarapatti Revenue Village, Thandarampattu Talu, Thiruvannamalai District.

2.Heard Mr.T.Dhanasekaran, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and Mr.M.R.Gokul Krishnan, learned Additional Government Pleader appearing on behalf of the respondents 1 to 3.



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3. The grievance of the petitioner is that he is possession and enjoyment of the property in S.No.10/32. The 4th and 5th respondents are said to have blocked the access of the petitioner from reaching his residential house and started construction activities. Immediately, the petitioner requested them to remove the block in the access, but no action was taken. The 4th and 5th respondents also started constructing a house in the land and also got a natham patta for S.No.10/73. According to the petitioner, this patta was obtained and construction activities were done by completely concealing the fact that the petitioner's house is situated on the eastern side and their only access to the property is being blocked. The petitioner made a representation in this regard to the 2nd respondent. A representation was given to the respondents 1 to 3 on 16.09.2024. On receipt of the same, the 2nd respondent through letter dated 25.09.2024 directed the 3rd respondent to conduct an enquiry and to submit a report. Since the same was not considered, the present writ petition has been filed before this Court.

4. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the materials placed before this Court and also the nature of grievance expressed



by the petitioner, there shall be a direction to the 3rd respondent to act upon the representation made by the petitioner on 16.09.2024 and also communication made by the 2nd respondent to the 3rd respondent on 25.09.2024 and conduct an enquiry by calling the petitioner and respondents 4 and 5 and necessary orders shall be passed by the 3rd respondent, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

5.This writ petition is disposed of with the above directions. No Costs.

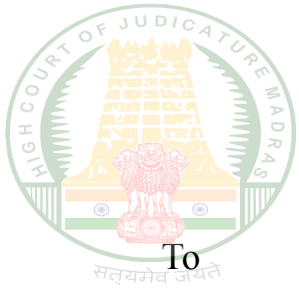
