ORDER

In a proposed suit for recovery of money towards unpaid dues on supply of goods, the intending plaintiff seeks leave to sue the respondents before this Court. In the draft plaint, it is stated that a part of the cause of action arose in Chennai since the invoices were raised at Chennai and payments were made at Chennai. Learned counsel also relies upon the clause in the invoice agreeing to the jurisdiction of courts in Chennai.

Upon examining the draft plaint and the documents annexed thereto, it appears that a part of the cause of action has arisen in Chennai and parties have agreed to submit disputes to courts in Chennai.
