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respondent police confirms the fact that the petitioner has been complying with the condition regularly; and that the investigation is pending.

Considering the submissions of both sides and the nature of offence, the condition imposed on the petitioner to appear before the respondent police station daily at 10:00 a.m., in Crl.O.P.No.269 of 2025 dated 20.01.2025, is **modified** to the effect that **the petitioner shall report before the respondent police station on every Monday at 10:30 a.m., until further orders.**

5. Accordingly, this criminal miscellaneous petition is ordered.
