The present Civil Miscellaneous Appeal is filed against the order dated 25.09.2019 passed in MCOP No.228 of 2019 on the file of the Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal / Special District Court for Motor Accident Claims Cases, Krishnagiri.

MEMORANDUM OF COMPROMISE BETWEEN ALL PARTIES

1. It is respectfully submitted that the above CMA. No.1777 of 2020 was filed challenging the award dated 25.09.2019 made in M.C.O.P.No.228 of 2019 on the file of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal / Special District Court for Motor Accident Claims Cases, Krishnagiri.

2. It is submitted that the appellant is the vehicle owner and respondents 1 to 4 are claimants. The 5th respondent is the driver of the vehicle and remains exparty before trial Court. The 6th respondent is the purchaser of the vehicle. During pendency of the above C.M.A., all the parties, have amicably resolved to settle the dispute in terms of compromise.

3. The claimants/respondents 1 to 5 agreed for the one time settlement amount of Rs.15,00,000/- and the 6th respondent agreed to pay the amount. The demand drafts were drawn by the 6th respondent



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and handed over to the counsel for the respondents 1 to 5, on 09.12.2025 and the same was also handed over and acknowledged by the Counsel for respondents in the Hon'ble Court.

4. The following are the demand draft numbers and amount paid to the claimants 1 to 5. All the demand drafts were drawn from the State Bank of India, Sivanandhapuram Code No.21308, Coimbatore, dated 27.11.2025.

5. The claimants 1 to 4 agrees that it is one time settlement and there is no future claim from any one including 6th respondent towards the death of Mr.Govindasami.

The appellant also entitled to get refund of Rs.25,000/- deposited before Motor Accident Claims Tribunal / Special District Court for Motor Accident Claims Cases, Krishnagiri in M.C.O.P.No.228 of 2019 deposit towards filing this appeal along with accrued interest if any.



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All the parties mutually agreed and signed and pray this Hon'ble Court to dispose the C.M.A.No.1777 of 2020 in terms of the compromise and thus render justice.
