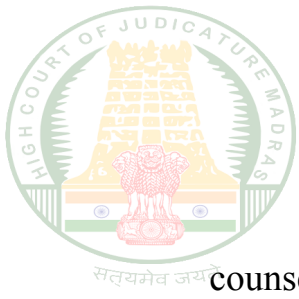
ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking for a Writ of Mandamus, to direct the 1st respondent to pay the Employees provident fund to the petitioner vide representation dated 23.12.2024 within a time frame fixed by this Court.

2. Since no adverse order has been passed against the 2nd respondent, notice to the 2nd respondent is dispensed with.

3. Mr.Arun Dhanapalan, learned counsel, accepts notice on behalf

of the 1st respondent. In view of the consent expressed by the learned



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counsel for the parties, this Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission itself.

4. The case of the petitioner is that, he worked as housekeeping boy in the 2nd respondent management from 01.03.2018 to 31.05.2020. During that period, the provident fund contribution was collected by the 2nd respondent and the same was deposited to the 1st respondent. Whiles, he came to know that while depositing the contribution to the 1st respondent, it was wrongly deposited to the account of one A.Perumal, having UAN No.100419074607, whereas, the provident fund account of the petitioner is UAN No.101806729463. Thereafter, he approached the 1st respondent to pay his provident fund and the 1st respondent asked him to provide the joint declaration and other documents and the same has been submitted by the petitioner on 27.05.2022. Again, he was asked to produce the affidavit and indemnity body from the 2nd respondent, which was also submitted before the 1st respondent on 07.11.2022. Even though



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the petitioner had submitted all the required documents, the 1st respondent had not taken any action. Therefore, on 23.12.2024, he sent a detailed representation to the 1st respondent. Since the same was not considered, the petitioner filed this writ petition before this court.

5. Though very many grounds have been raised in this writ petition, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that, it would suffice, if this Court issues a direction to the 1st respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 23.12.2024 within a time frame that may be stipulated by this court.

6. Considering the limited request made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this court, without going into the merits of the case, directs the 1st respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 23.12.2024 on merits and in accordance with law and pass appropriate orders, within a period of eight (8) weeks from the date of



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receipt of a copy of this order, after affording an opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioner and aggrieved persons, if any.

7. With the above direction, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
