ORDER

The Criminal Revision Petition is preferred against the order dated 19.10.2023 passed in M.C.No.181 of 2019 by the Additional Principal Judge, Principal Judge (FAC), Principal Family Court at Coimbatore.

2. Heard Mr.B.Sundarapandiyan, learned counsel on record for



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petitioner and Mr.Kandhan Duraiswami, learned counsel on record for respondent.

3. On 28.08.2024, at the request of the learned counsel appearing for the respective parties, the matter was directed to be posted before the Tamil Nadu Mediation and Conciliation Centre, High Court, Madras for arriving at an amicable settlement.

4. Today, when the matter was taken up for hearing, both the learned counsel submit that *lis* has since been settled before the Tamil Nadu Mediation and Conciliation Centre, High Court, Madras and Settlement Agreement dated 15.11.2024 has been entered into between the parties. 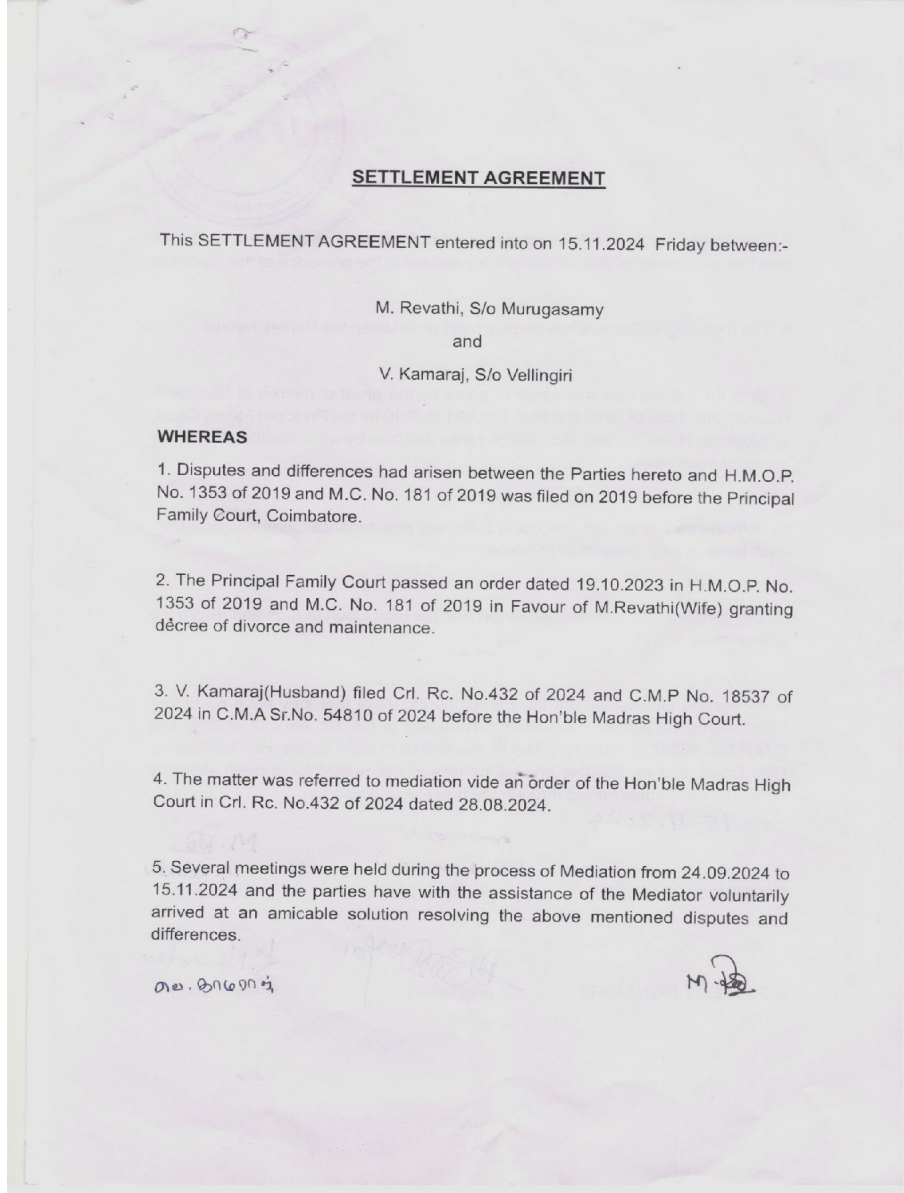
