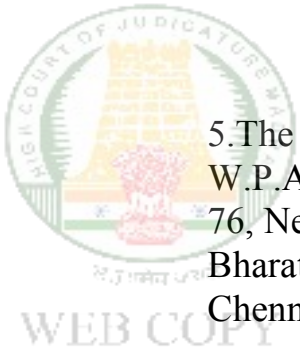

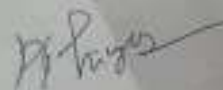
Respected Sir,

I am the counsel on record for the Petitioner in the above Writ Petition.

The said Writ Petition was filed praying for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to release all statutory benefits, including increments and other service benefits, withheld from the academic year 2018-2019, and to continue to pay such benefits without insisting upon the Petitioner to qualify by passing the TET examination, in terms of G.O.Ma.No.181, School Education (C2) Department, dated 15.11.2011.
