ORDER

This writ petition has been filed seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing respondents 1 to 3, particularly, the second respondent to deal with the representation made by the petitioner on 21.01.2025 wherein the petitioner is seeking for cancellation of patta issued in the name of the fourth respondent.

2. Heard Mr.V.Vijayakumar, learned counsel for petitioner and Mr.M.R.Gokulkrishnan, learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for respondents 1 to 3.

3. It is seen from records that the representation made by the petitioner was already forwarded by the first respondent to the third respondent for taking action and in spite of the same, no action was taken



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by the respondents 2 and 3. Left with no other option, the present writ petition has been filed before this Court.

4. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the materials placed before this Court, there shall be a direction to the second respondent to deal with the representation made by the petitioner on 21.01.2025 after affording opportunity to the fourth respondent on its own merits and in accordance with law and pass orders within a period of eight (8) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

This writ petition is disposed of with the above direction. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
