ORDER

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed for a direction, directing the first respondent to defreeze the petitioner's Current Account bearing No.05407610000083 maintained with the third respondent.

2. Heard the learned counsel appearing on either side and perused the materials available on record.

3. The petitioner is having a Current Account with the third respondent. Based on the request made by the first respondent, the account of the petitioner was frozen by the third respondent and the petitioner was not permitted to operate his account.



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4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the

first respondent submitted that by a communication dated 28.03.2025, the first respondent had already instructed the third respondent to defreeze the petitioner's account and permit the petitioner to operate his account. The issue arose due to a technical glitch, which has now been resolved by the concerned Anti-virus company.

5. In view of the above, the petitioner is permitted to operate his account.

6. With the above direction, this Criminal Original Petition stands disposed of.
