This case came up for settlement before the National Lok Adalat.

Both the parties are present. Mr.T.A.Srinivasan, the learned counsel for the Appellant and Mr.S.Senthil, the learned counsel for the respondents are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties, they arrived at a compromise to settle the matter as follows:

COMMON TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

The Appellant-D.Rajendran, originally filed a case before the Joint commissioner of Workmen Compensation, Coonoor, Nilgiris District seeking compensation of Rs.10,00,000/- for the injury sustained in his eye. As the prayer was rejected by the Joint Commissioner, the present appeal has been preferred by D.Rajendran before the Hon'ble High Court.

2. Both the parties having initiated negotiation successfully arrived at a settlement of all the issues arisen in this case and filed a terms of compromise before the lok adalat along with Demand draft for a sum of Rs.10,00,000/-. (Demand Draft No.827603 dated 10.12.2025) which is extracted as under:

TERMS OF COMPROMISE

Filed before the Lok Adalat held on 13.12.2025

1. It is submitted that the Appellant had filed the CMA.No.1480 of 2023 against the Respondents, against the order dated 16.12.2019 passed by the Commissioner for Workmen's Compensation, Coonoor, in E.C.No.171 of 2016, rejecting the claim filed by the Appellant seeking for compensation from the Respondent that the accident caused to the Petitioner.
2. It is submitted that though the accident is not occurred to the Appellant during the Course of employment with the Respondents, on the humanitarian ground and to buy peace, the Respondents came forward to pay a sum of Rs.10,00,000/- to the Appellant as a full and final settlement amount, which was also agreed by the Appellant. As such the Demand Draft dated 10.12.2025 in bearing No.827603 drawn on Karur Vysya Bank, Namakkal Main Branch, is taken in the name of the Appellant by the Respondent and handed over to the same today (13.12.2025).



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3. It is submitted that on receipt of the Demand Draft, being fully satisfied, the Appellant agrees that he will not make any further claim in any manner, pertaining to compensation or other monetary benefit from the Respondents at any time in the future and further agrees to withdraw the CMA.No.1480 of 2023 pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Madras as Settled out of Court.

Therefore, it is humbly prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to record the Terms of Compromise and ^{dispose}~~dismiss~~ the Appeal and thus render justice.

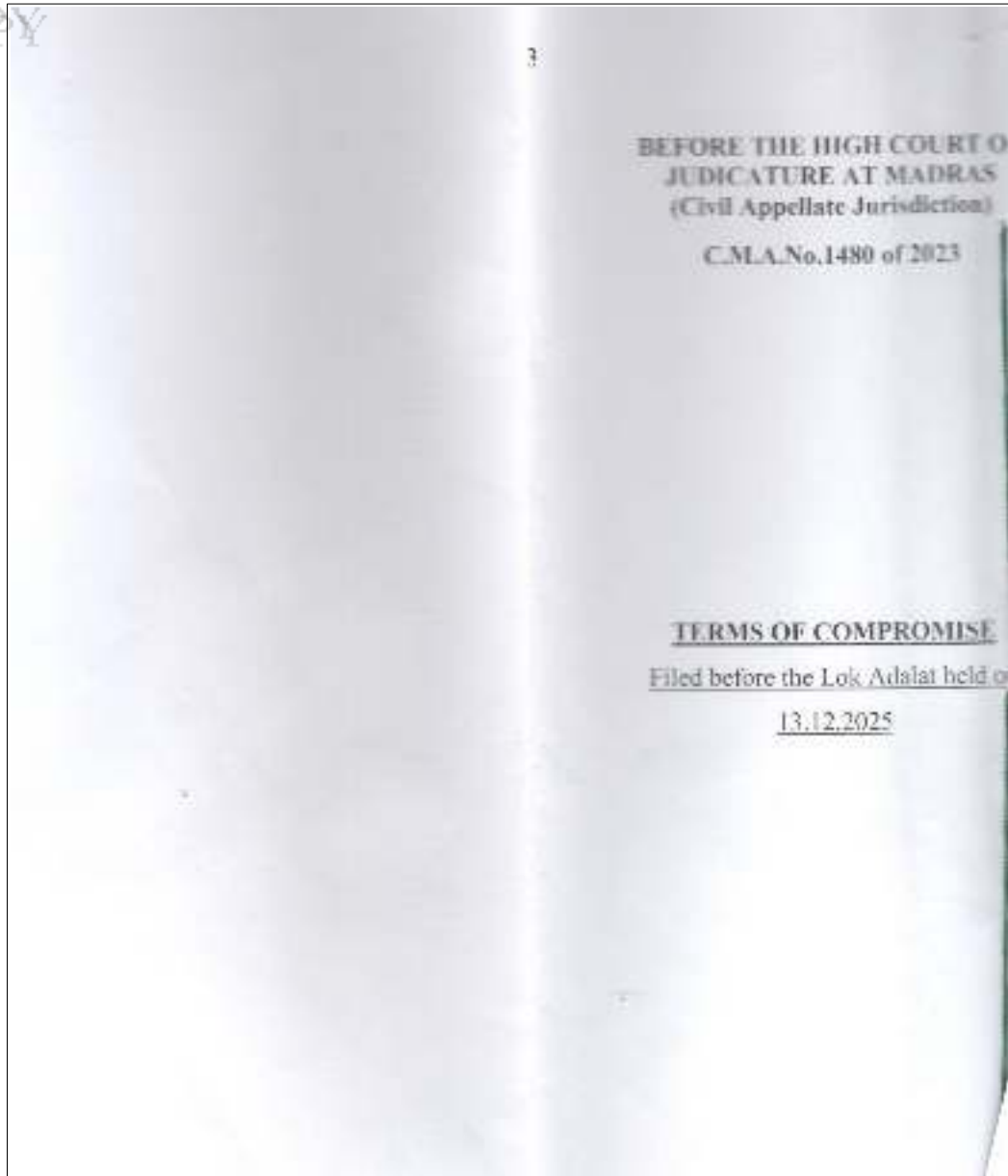

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3. Both the parties made a formal request to the lok adalat in terms of the above settlement.

4. As a result, the award is passed recording the terms of the compromise jointly placed by both the parties, the first respondent Rama Srinivasan, Proprietor, Srinivasa Corporation has issued a Demand Draft for a sum of Rs.10,00,000/- as agreed between the parties to the



Appellant, D.Rajendran, herein.

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5. Both the parties have compromised the issues arisen in this case, and produced the terms of compromise before the lok adalat and the demand draft for a sum of Rs.10,00,000/- is handed over to the Appellant herein.

6. Consequently, the Civil Miscellaneous Appeal stands disposed of. The court fee paid by the appellant be refunded.
