WEB COPY 3. We find from the records that the prisoner was recently granted leave from 21.08.2024 to 26.08.2024 and 21 days from 28.11.2024 to 18.12.2024 by this Court. Since he has not completed one year from the last leave granted, he would not be entitled for ordinary leave under the Tamil Nadu Suspension of Sentence Rules, 1982. In this background, we are not inclined to entertain the prayer sought for in this Writ Petition.

4. Accordingly, this Writ Petition stands dismissed. No Costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
