ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking for a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent to permit the petitioner to remit a sum of Rs.10,24,898/- determined in terms of order under Section 7Q of the Employees' Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 dated 02.01.2025 in proceedings no.TN/RO/CHN/I/CC-I/TNMA0051086000/DIV.25/PD C/2024 in 15 equated monthly instalments commencing from the month of March 2025.

2. Mr.K.Venkatesan, learned Standing Counsel, takes notice on behalf of the respondent. In view of the consent expressed by the learned counsel appearing for the parties, this Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission itself.

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5. On the above contentions, heard the learned Standing Counsel appearing for the respondent and perused the materials available on record.

In view of the limited request made by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, this Court, without going into the merits of the case, permits the petitioner to remit the entire demand amount of Rs.10,24,898/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs Twenty Four Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety Eight only) by way of Ten (10) equated monthly installments, commencing from 7th April, 2025 and shall continue to pay the installments on or before 7th of every succeeding English Calendar month, failing which, it is open to the respondent to initiate appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law.
