The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that in view of the latest decision reported in 2020 (1) *C.W.C Pg.417 (E.S.Sundara Mahalingam Vs. Special Tribunal)*, the writ petition is not maintainable and it is only a C.R.P that is maintainable. According to him several writ petitions have been converted as C.R.P after the above judgment of the Division Bench. Therefore, he would request this Court to convert this writ petition into C.R.P and post before the roster judge.
