ORDER

The revision petitioner is a third party to the suit in O.S.No.227/2011 who has filed I.A.No.173 of 2022 on the file of Sub Court, Palladam, to implead himself in the application in I.A.No.355 of 2018 filed by the plaintiff/first respondent herein to pass a final decree.
